## *KOI HEALTH ESSENTIALS*

<b>Good Pond and Filtration design</b>	Ensure correct flow rates and filter retention time.
<b>Water Quality Management</b>	Ensure wholesome water supply.. Test for AT LEAST nitrite and ammonia. (pH test would be good) Regular removal of rubbish and floating debris
<b>Plenty of Aeration</b>	In pond and within filter system.
<b>Feeding</b>	Good quality food A little and often is better than all at once. Wheatgerm in low temperatures.
<b>Medication</b>	Medicate ONLY when you know the cause. Seek advise BEFORE medicating if you are unsure
<b>Stocking</b>	Don't overstock. Remember to allow for growth.
<b>Winterisation</b>	Cover and/or heat if possible Turn off waterfalls and fountains Do NOT turn off filtration
<b>Quarantine System</b>	For new stock and infected fish.
